

Monthly Board Update to Staff

January 2018

Misty Gallegos presented the financial report and the current district enrollment numbers. As of the first of the month, district enrollment was 1050 students. You can find the full enrollment and financial report on BoardDocs.

Lance West, Transportation Coordinator, and Misty Gallegos, Business Manager, presented a bus replacement proposal to the board. Due to the cost of repairs for one of our older buses, the bus has been approved by the WDE for an emergency replacement. The board approved the purchase of a new bus.

Malena Crites, Christina Williams and Justine Lamphere were approved for the para pool. Also approved were Eric Allen as assistant Jr. High boys basketball coach and Wendy Stoffer as regular route driver.

Discussion on the Mathematics Summit Conference took place at both the COW and Board meeting this month. The feedback from our teachers and administrators that attended was positive and encouraging.

The annual memo of intent will be completed electronically and will only be sent to teaching staff. More information regarding this topic is being emailed to all LCSD#2 staff.

Superintendent Jon Abrams informed the board that computer science/coding courses will be added next year. The curriculum for these courses is still a work in process. Because of a significant need for teachers and a very limited pool statewide, PTSB is working with school districts to allow for greater flexibility for teachers to become certified in these areas than in the past.
