

## SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS AND MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Trustees of Laramie County District No. 2 shall consist of nine (9) members. In electing members to the Board of Trustees, the District shall be divided into four trustee areas with the following representation:

1. Trustee Area C – One (1) member: Trustee Area C shall incorporate the following area:

Beginning at the Nebraska state border and County Road 219, west on Road 219 to State Highway 215 then north to County Road 220, then west to County Road 162, then southwest to County Road 160, west along County Road 160 then north to County Road 219, west to County Road 158, then north to County Road 220, west to County Road 154, then south to County Road 219, west to County Road 149, then north to County Road 220, then west to County Road 143, north to County Road 222 then west to County Road 136, north to the Goshen County border, east to the Nebraska state border and south to the point of beginning at Road 219.

Trustee Area C is known as the Albin area.

2. Trustee Area D – Two (2) members: Trustee Area D shall incorporate the following area:

Beginning at the intersection of County Road 154 and Interstate 80, west on Interstate 80 to County Road 146, south to County Road 208, west to County Road 144, then south to County Road 207, then west to State Highway 217, north to County Road 208, generally west to a private dirt road at about mile 208 and then west along said dirt road to mile 138, north to Interstate 80, west to County Road 136, then north to County Road 222, east to County Road 143 then south to County Road 220, east to County Road 149 then south to County Road 219, east to County Road 154, then south to the point of beginning, County Road 154 and Interstate 80.

Trustee Area D is known as the Burns/Hillsdale area.

3. Trustee Area E – Two (2) members: Trustee Area E shall incorporate the following area:

Beginning at the intersection of the Nebraska and Colorado state borders, west on the Colorado border to County Road 161, north to County Road 206, west to

County Road 159, then north to County Road 210, west to County Road 154, north to County Road 220, east to County Road 158, then south to County Road 219, east to County Road 160, south and east along County Road 160 to County Road 162 then southeast to County Road 162, generally north to County Road 220, east to State Highway 215, south to County Road 219, east to the Nebraska Border, then south along the Nebraska border to the point of beginning.

Trustee Area E is known as the Pine Bluffs area.

4. Trustee Area F – One (1) member: Trustee Area F shall incorporate the following area:

Beginning at County Road 161 and the Colorado border, west on the Colorado state border to Road 136, north to Interstate 80, east to mile 138, generally south to a dirt road at mile 208, generally east along a dirt road to Road 217, south to County Road 207, east to County Road 144, north to County Road 208, east to County Road 146, then north to Interstate 80, east to County Road 154, south to County Road 210, east to County Road 159, south to County Road 206, then east to County Road 161, and south to the point of beginning at County Road 161 and the Colorado state border.

Trustee Area F is known as the Carpenter area.

5. District – Three (3) members to elected at-Large. Laramie County School District No. 2 shall incorporate the following area:

Beginning at the intersection of the Nebraska and Colorado state borders, west on the Colorado border to County Road 136, north to the Goshen County Border, east to the Nebraska state border, south to the intersection of the Colorado and Nebraska state borders.

All qualified electors in the school district shall be entitled to vote for the candidates of their choice from each of the trustee areas and the candidates at large.
