

Curriculum Development Adoption and Review

The Laramie County School District #2 curriculum based on the Wyoming state standards shall be the regular courses of study approved by the Board of Trustees and administered through the office of the Curriculum Director.

The Board of Trustees believes that the coordination and continuity of standards/curriculum planning is a vital part of the educative program for the District. The Board of Trustees establishes a Curriculum Coordinating Council (CCC) and grants it the authority to make recommendations to the Board regarding curriculum, instruction, assessment, and student learning. The CCC will adhere to the administrative procedures as established in Policy IG-R.

The Board is receptive to the input and expression of concerns by parents, educators, students, and patrons related to curriculum. The Board further encourages parent, student, and patron participation on curriculum committees. Stakeholders will submit input to the Curriculum Director. The Curriculum Director will facilitate the review, development, and curriculum revisions through the CCC.
