

## ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRA CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

It is a privilege and not a right for students enrolled in the school district to participate in the district's extra-curricular activities. Participation in such activities may be limited or conditioned upon compliance with school district policies, rules and regulations, and / or separate codes of conduct. Such privileges may also be conditioned upon rules of the Wyoming High School Activities Association. In addition the privilege may be impacted concerning attendance and maintaining satisfactory grades.

Each student must meet the eligibility requirements and policies of the Board of Trustees for Laramie County School District No. Two and the Wyoming High School Activities Association rules and regulations to be eligible to participate in school and extra-duty activities.

School activities are any activity in which the student is a participant, is sponsored by the WHSAA, and / or is considered to be extra-curricular. Extensions of classroom curriculum and academic award programs are exempt from these regulations.

Rules and regulations pertaining to other areas of participation, eligibility and training expectations are developed and recorded in the district student athletic /activity handbook. All sponsors, coaches, directors and principals will have a copy of the handbook for review and explanation for students and parents.
