

REPORT CARD/PROGRESS REPORTS

The Board believes that it is essential for parents to be kept fully informed of their children's progress in school. Parents may check progress of students through the district's on-line system.

A written report shall be provided to parents four times a year with supplementary reports sent as needed. Supplementary reports will be required for students in danger of failure. Notices of praise or letters noting outstanding achievement will be sent whenever a teacher or school official feels a student deserves recognition. Classroom teachers are responsible for grades for all students, except those on alternate standards.

Parent-teacher conferences will be used as an integral part of the reporting system. They are to be scheduled at least once a year into the annual district calendar. The principals will be responsible for making necessary conference arrangements.

Disputes involving grades may be reviewed by the principal. The judgment of the teacher shall be respected in grading the work of the pupil. The teacher shall accumulate sufficient evidence to justify grades given.
