

Jr. High Requirements

In accordance to W.S. 21-9-101, all Laramie County School District #2 students in grades 7-8 must have the opportunity to learn the required state content and performance standards established for the Common Core of Knowledge and Common Core of Skills described in W.S. 21-3-304 (a)(iii). These content areas include:

- Language Arts
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Health
- P.E.
- Fine & Performing Arts
- Career/Vocational

To meet those standards, students in Laramie 2 must complete the following:

Language Arts –

7th Grade English Language Arts (1 full year)

8th Grade English Language Arts (1 full year)

Mathematics –

7th Grade Mathematics (1 full year)

8th Grade mathematics (1 full year)

Science –

7th Grade Science (1 full year)

8th Grade Science (1 full year)

Social Studies –

7th Grade Social Studies (1 full year)

8th Grade Social Studies (1 full year)

Health –

Jr. High Health (1 semester)

P.E. –

Jr. High P.E. (1 semester)

Fine & Performing Arts –

Jr. High Band (1 full year) *or*

Jr. High Choir (1 full year) *or*

7th Grade Art (1 full year) *or*
8th Grade Art (1 full year)

Career Vocational –

FCS Exploration (1 quarter)
Ag Exploration (1 quarter)
Tech Ed Exploration (1 quarter)
Business Exploration (1 quarter)
Basic Computer Skills (1 year)

This totals 24 semesters (48 quarters) of required courses,
leaving 8 semesters (16 quarters) of time for schools to add school specific courses.

Students with the most significant cognitive disabilities may use Wyoming Standards Extensions that show a clear link to the content standards for the grade in which the student is enrolled, although the grade-level content may be reduced in complexity or modified to reflect pre-requisite skills.
