OUT OF DISTRICT ATTENDANCE

Considering that Laramie County School District #2 has limited resources, the granting of approval of out of district students is contingent on the following:

1. That the school(s) have and continue to have adequate room in the aforementioned schools for students who are residents of the district. Should overcrowding become an issue, out of district students may be asked to return to their home school district or pay tuition as established by the Board of Trustees.
2. Those out of district students through their own volition, not making responsible progress toward the completion of the programs or courses or with excessive absences or tardiness:
 - A parent conference with the counselor will be arranged at the onset of problems and a plan of remediation will be put into place.
 - Should the plan fail to result in solving the problem, the parent or guardian will be asked to enroll the student in his/her home district with the next quarter after notification that remediation of the problem has not been successful.
3. The third and most salient reasons that out of district students will be denied the right to continue to attend the above named schools will be violations of disciplinary categories. A complete list of District Policy Categories may be obtained upon request. A summary is as follows:
 - Category I Violation: This includes arson, weapons, or bomb threat. An out of district student with a single violation in this area will be denied further attendance immediately upon determination of his/her guilt of this category.
 - Category II Violation: This includes willful damage to school or personal property, stealing (grades 7-12), possession of any controlled substance, false fire alarm, possessing any object or material generally considered to be a weapon, fighting, etc. An out of district student with a single violation in this area will be denied further attendance.
 - Category III Violation: This includes trespassing on school property, insubordination, tobacco use, stealing (grades K-6) etc. An out of district student with three (3) documented violations of this category will be denied further attendance. Parents or guardians will be notified by letter at the second violation that the next violation will result in denial to attend.

The following statement of affirmation must be completed, signed and dated in order to be allowed to attend by an out of district student.
