Monthly Board Update

October 2021

- Roy Taranto a Senior at Pine Bluffs High School was recognized with a WHSAA Good Sportsmanship Award for his exemplary conduct and good sportsmanship shown during the game on September 24, 2021 against Southeast. Congratulations!
- We received 21.8% of the general fund budgeted revenues for FY2022. This compares to last year when we had received 11.1% of the budgeted revenues. We have expended and encumbered 84.2% of the budgeted amount for FY2022. This compares to FY2021 when we had encumbered and expended 87.9% of the budgeted amount.
- Mr. Pierantoni explained the District email that is being used to send quarantine information to parents. Mr. Pierantoni clarified quarantine is 24 hours not just during school hours.
- Policies GCC (Staff Leaves and Absences), GCAB/GCAB-R (Professional Staff Certification), GCQC (Resignation of Contracted Staff), and the new policy GDQC (Resignation of Classified Staff) passed the first reading.
- The Board acknowledged the resignations of Bailey Pachel, Paraprofessional Albin Elementary School; Kay Dersham, RN School Nurse; Michelle Modlin, Paraprofessional Carpenter Elementary.
- The Board approved the hires of Neal Obland, Lash Branigan, Deron Jackson, and Chelsea Jackson as Substitute Bus Drivers; Ariel Barrett, School Nurse; Kelby Hinton, School Nurse – Esser; Jennifer Smith, Diane Roberts, and Wendy Smith for the Para Pool; Candice Halligan, Young Author Extra Duty. Approved the transfer of Jeff Munoz from Sub Bus Driver to Permanent Bus Driver.
- Chairman Randall discussed the schedule for the School Report presentation to the Board.
- Ms. Kim Nelson provided an update to the Board regarding facility renovations and repairs.
- Ms. Traci Schneider gave the Curriculum update. Ms. Schneider advised there will be a meeting for the Perkins Grant on October 15.
